Home vs House

Home is where you live and where you have an emotional attachment; homelessness is a misnomer; unhoused or houseless is a more accurate

Unsheltered

Refers to the lack of physical shelter, even temporarily. 'Homeless' implies a lack of permanent housing.

Hostile Architecture/Defensive Design

Features implemented into city and town planning designed to deter homeless people from sleeping in that location.

Housing Insecurity

Not having a secure shelter due to various factors like low income, high housing costs, unstable neighborhoods, etc.

Permanent Supportive Housing

An alternative solution to end homelessness that focuses on accessible permanent housing and coordinated services such as financial assistance and mental health treatment.

1640: The first recorded instance of homelessness in the land that is now the U.S.

1955: Release of Lady & The Tramp, providing a 'positive' representation of homelessness for children.

1965: Department of Urban Development (HUD) created to provide public housing under Johnson's *Great Society Plan*.

pandemic creates instability and oversaturation of an already failing system.

2022: The Federal Strategic Plan All In is created, laying out a strategy for everyone having access to a home.
