### ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI)

machines or computer systems simulating human intelligence

### GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (GAI)

AI capable of producing images, video, text, etc. such as MidJourney, Pika, ChatGPT

the fabrications of AI that are based on patterns or objects that do not exist or that are imperceptible to humans
